

TSCA Restrictions Declaration Letter

Arista Corporation hereby declares that it is compliant with the requirements of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) regarding the five (5) Persistent, Bioaccumulative, and Toxic (PBT) chemicals listed below and that none of the chemicals are intentionally used or added to our products.

Persistent, Bioaccumulative, and Toxic (PBT) Chemicals Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
2, 4, 6-Tris (tert-butyl) phenol (2, 4, 6-TTBP)
Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

The Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), amended by Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act, opened provisions for evaluation and assessment of chemicals and subsequent enforcement of final rules passed to the federal register. Section 6 of TSCA allows for substances to be restricted in all states of the U.S. The TSCA Section 6 restrictions include the substances and groups that have been identified by the EPA as posing unreasonable risk to humans and the environment. Some of the chemicals with restrictions can be used in certain scopes, with applicable exemptions.
